BASED ON LUKE 17:11-19 NIV.

CUT OUT THE PIECES. GLUE SMALL PIECES OF SANDPAPER OR FELT ON THE BACK OF EACH PIECE, SO THEY WILL STICK TO A FLANNEL BOARD. USE THESE FLANNELGRAPH PIECES TO TELL THE STORY OF HOW JESUS HEALED THE TEN LEPERS USING THE STORY INCLUDED AT THE END OF THIS ACTIVITY.


Scene 1: On His way to Jerusalem, as Jesus was going into a village, ten men who were unwell met Him.
