

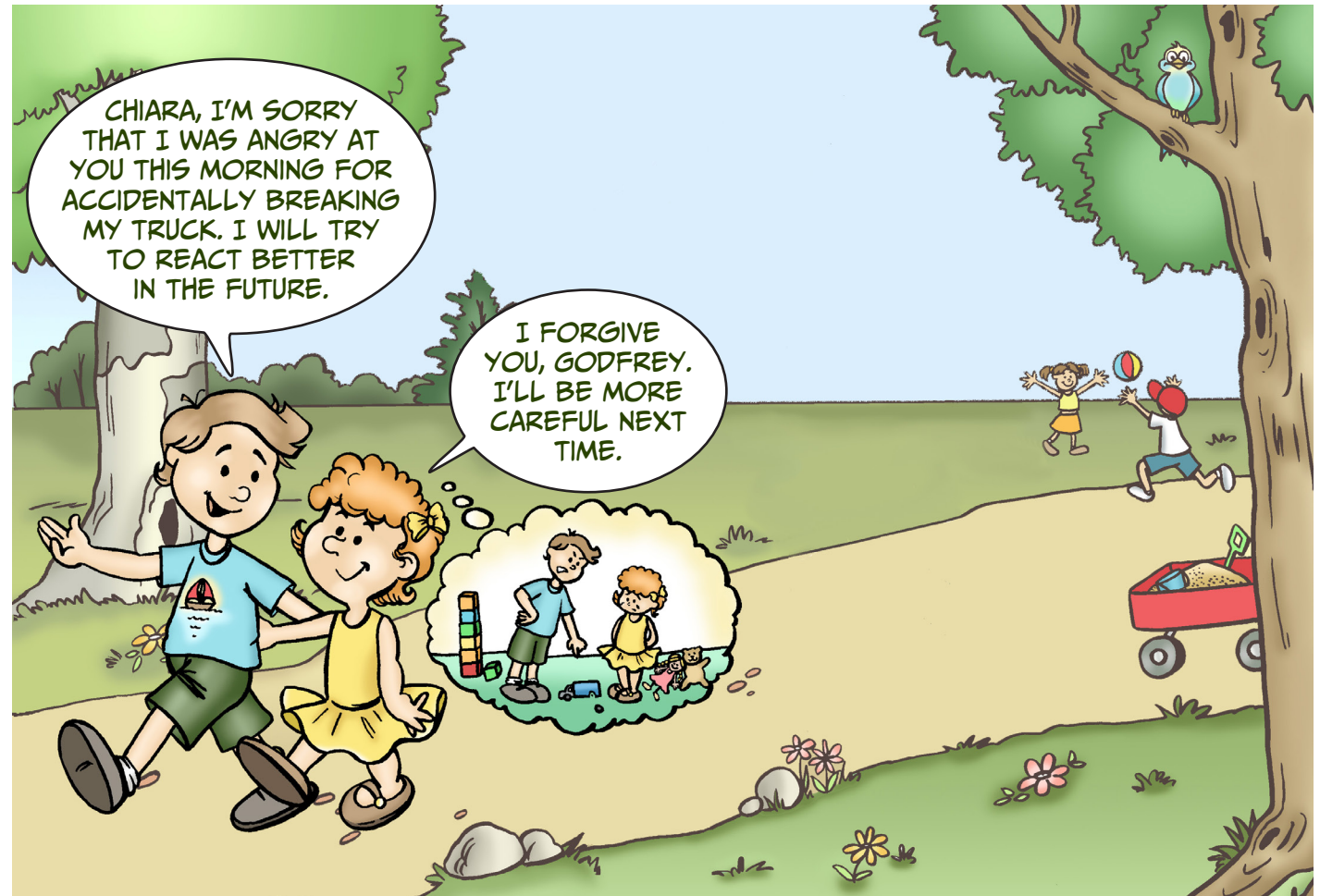
# Make Wrongs Right Again

“The Lord shows mercy and is kind. He does not become angry quickly, and he has great love. He will not always scold us. He will not be angry forever. ... He has taken our sins away from us” (Psalm 103:8–9,12 ICB).
