

God's Gift of Salvation

"In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him" (1 John 4:9 NKJV).




Jesus wants to be a part of our lives. He knocks on the door of our hearts and asks if He can enter. He wants to live within us so that we can be closer to God like He is.

We need Jesus' help in our lives. We need His forgiveness for the wrong that we do.


When Jesus came to earth and died for us, He did it so that we could receive God's gift of eternal life and salvation.
