
SALVATION IS FREE

[Jesus] saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5 NLT).

God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. (Ephesians 2:8– 9 NLT)



For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans 6:23 NLT).

Question: So all I need to do to be saved is to believe that Jesus is God's Son, and that He gave His life to save me from my sins?

That's right! The gift of salvation from our sins is a free gift that Jesus paid for. All we need to do is believe Jesus did this for us, and thank Him for it!
