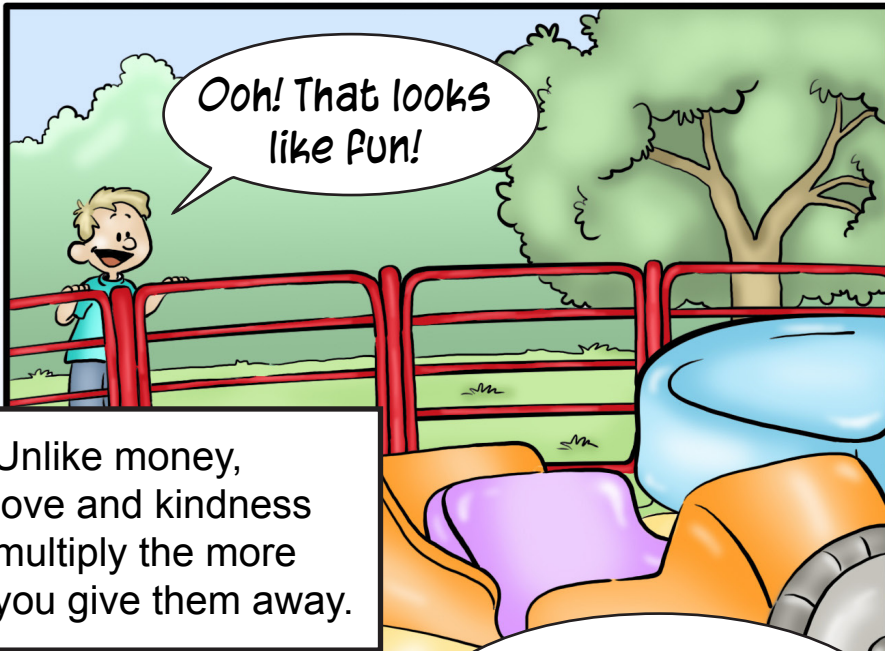
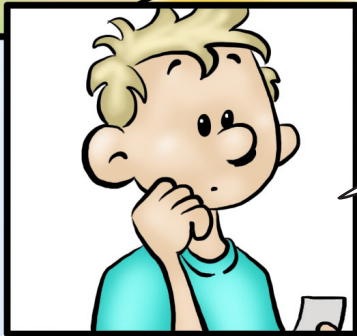
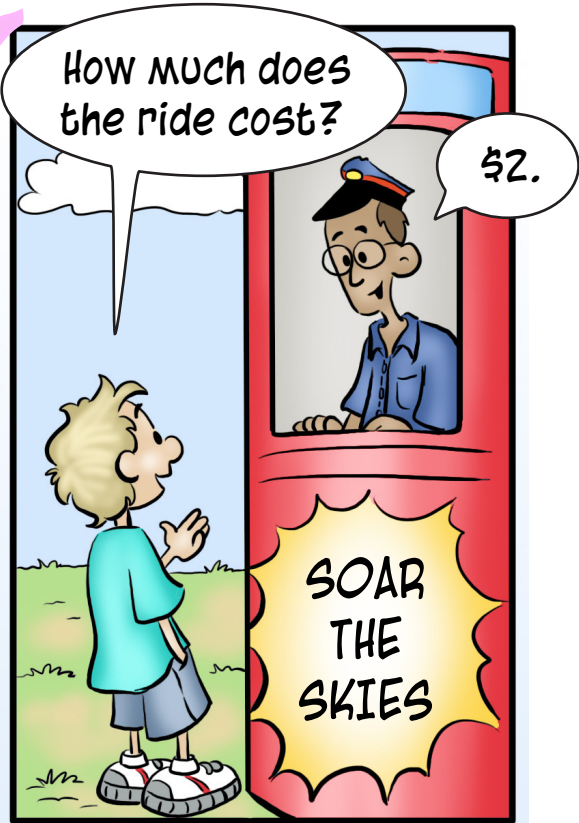


Love Goes on Forever

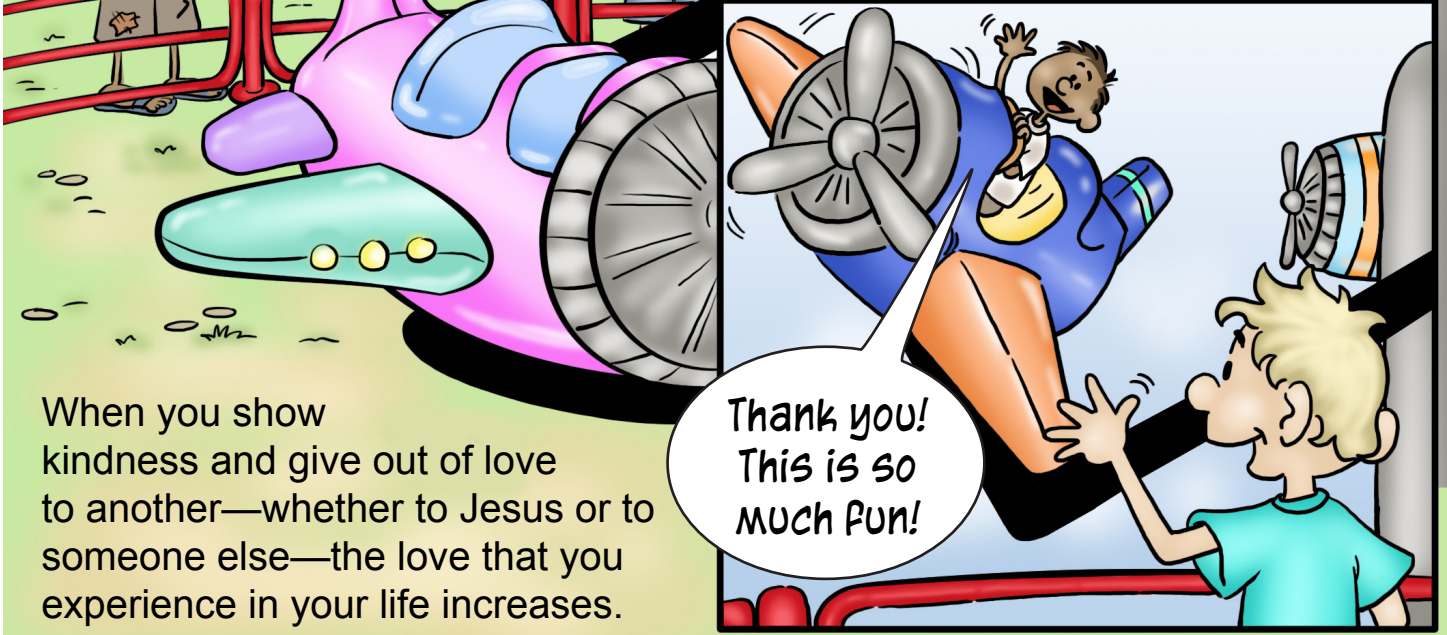
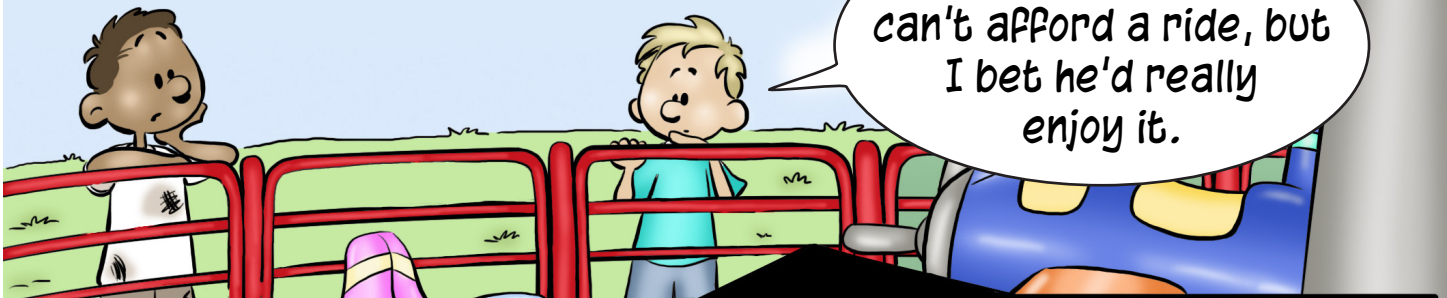


Unlike money, love and kindness multiply the more you give them away.



The ride would be fun, but then my money will be gone.

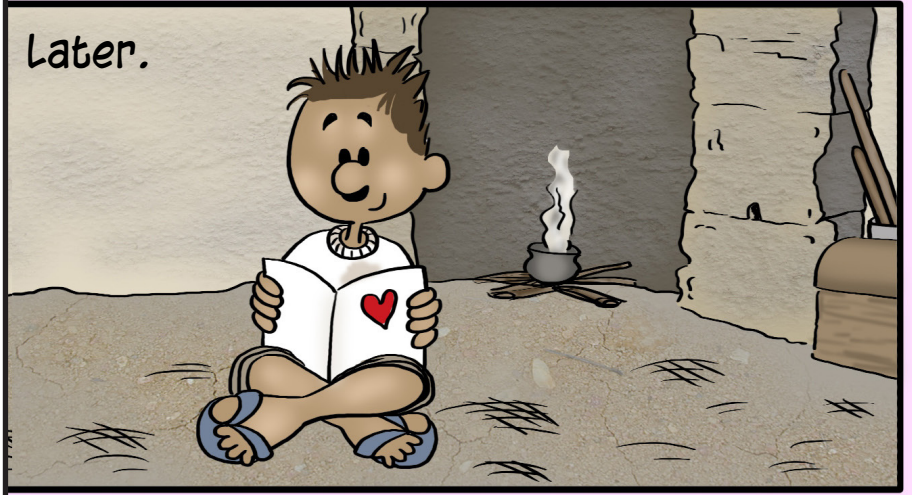
When you do something for love, you get more love in return.

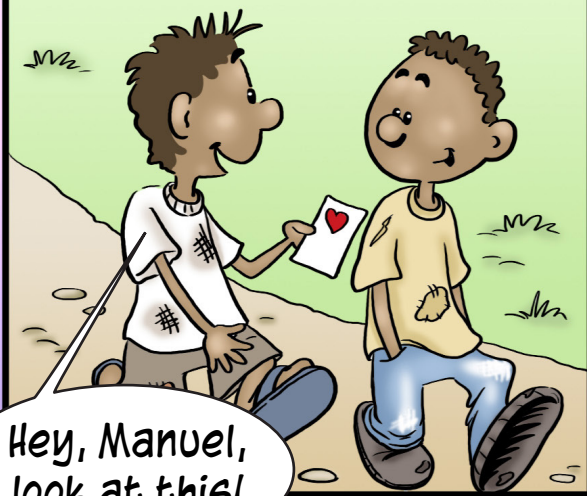
