



A POEM OF THANKFULNESS



and sunny skies,








For amazing ants that remind me to "stick,"

Heavenly halos bright as a lit-candle's wick.








And field mice that live off the land.

For jostling jalopies that Grandpa once rode,







And treasure hunts and friends' secret codes.

Red-red rambutans are so tasty, I find.




For dexterous yo-yos lined in a row,
