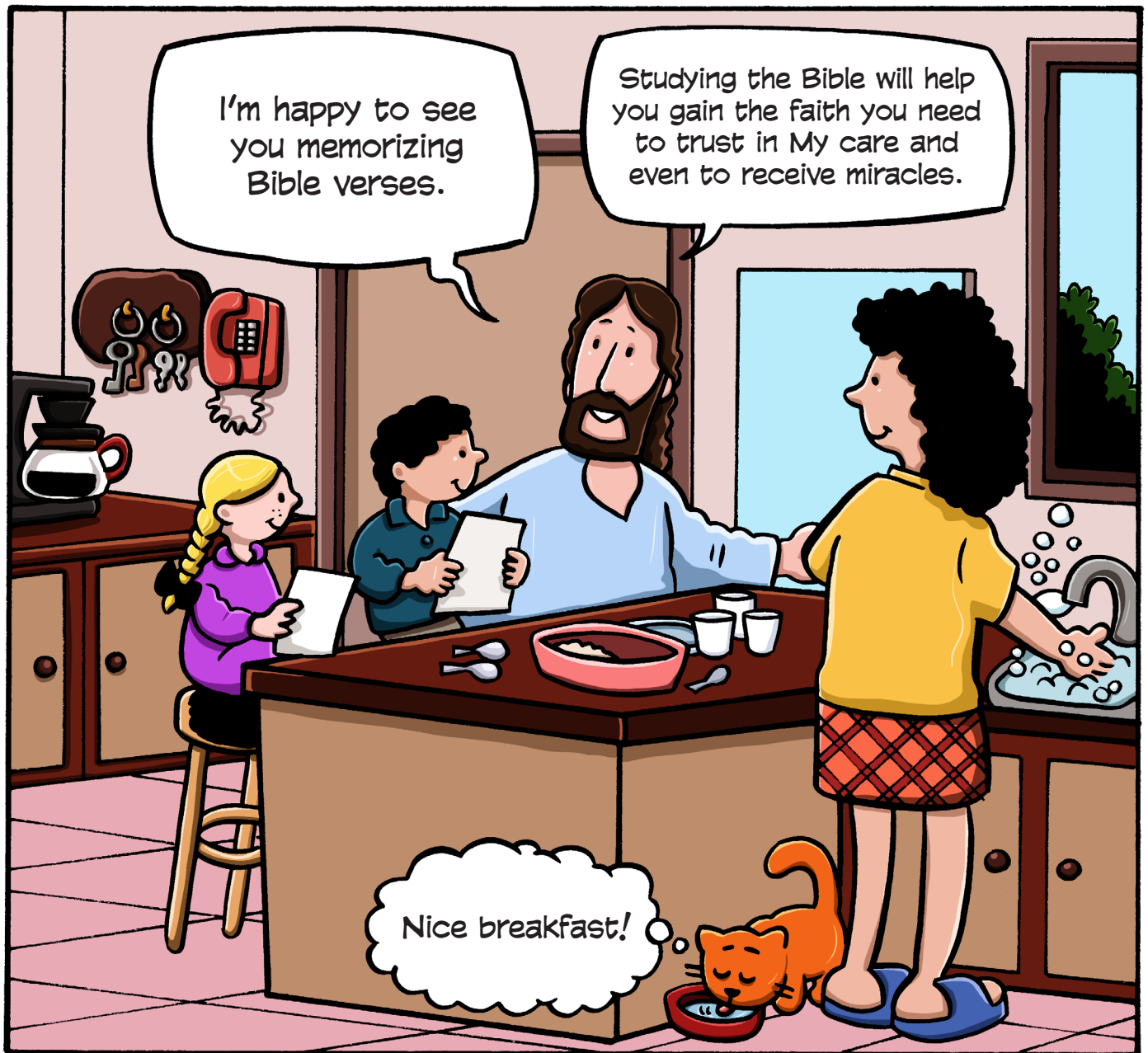


# NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR GOD

Three things to help you have faith to receive answers to prayers,

1:

Keep your faith strong by

2:

3:

Put your faith into action! When God shows you the way to go, trust Him and act on it!

Oh, Lord, what will we do?

Command the priests that bear the Ark of the Covenant, that when they come to the edge of the Jordan, they are to stand in the water.



Remember the priests who needed to cross the Jordan River with the Ark? God told them to go ahead and start walking, even though they still saw the water.<sup>5</sup>

They got all the way to the river, and when their feet touched the water, God stopped the water and made them a path to walk on. If they would have waited for the water to stop before they started walking, the water wouldn't have stopped, and they never would have made it across.
