(Exodus 20:15 ESV).

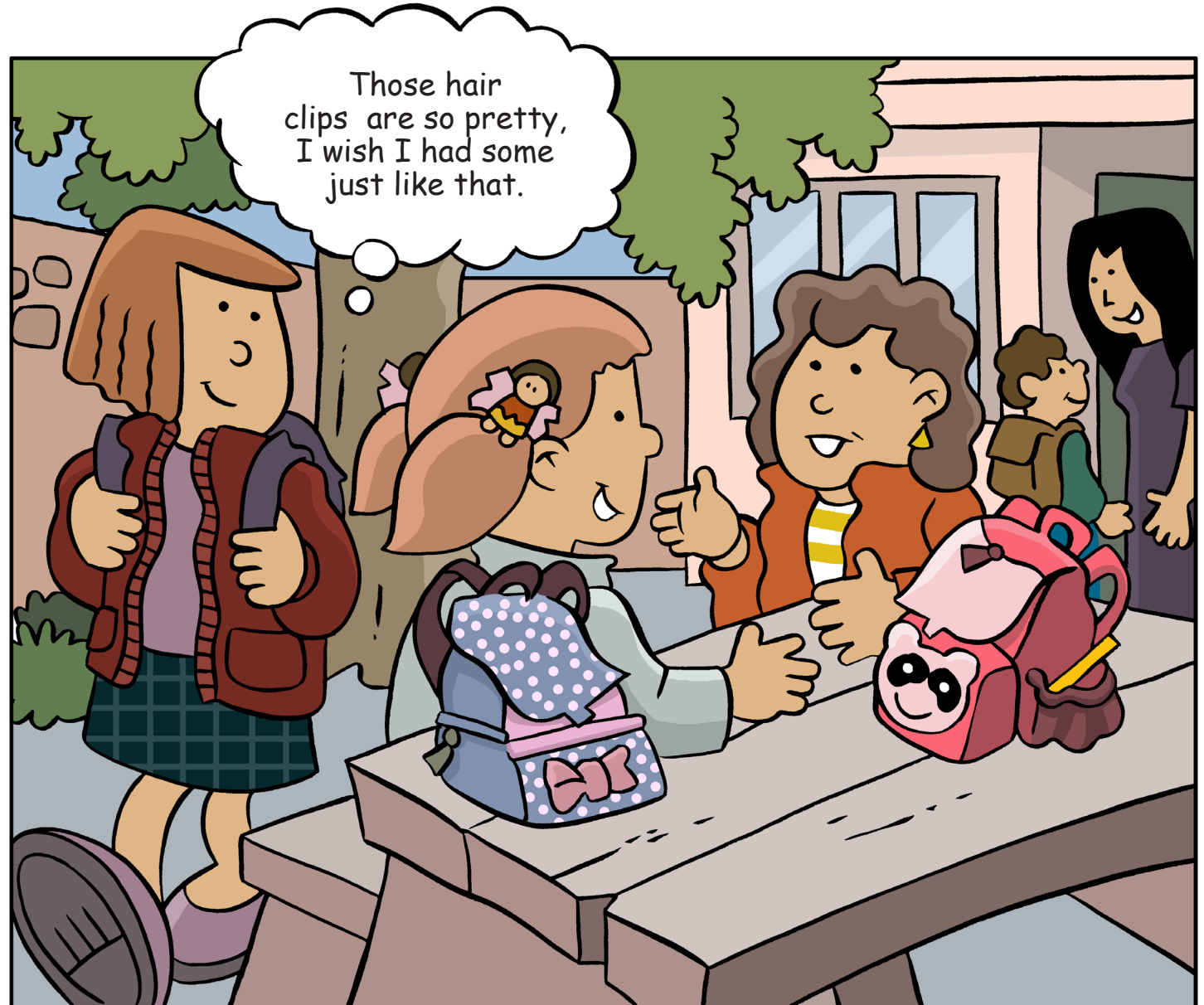
When we love God with all of our heart, soul, and mind, and our neighbor as ourselves ...¹

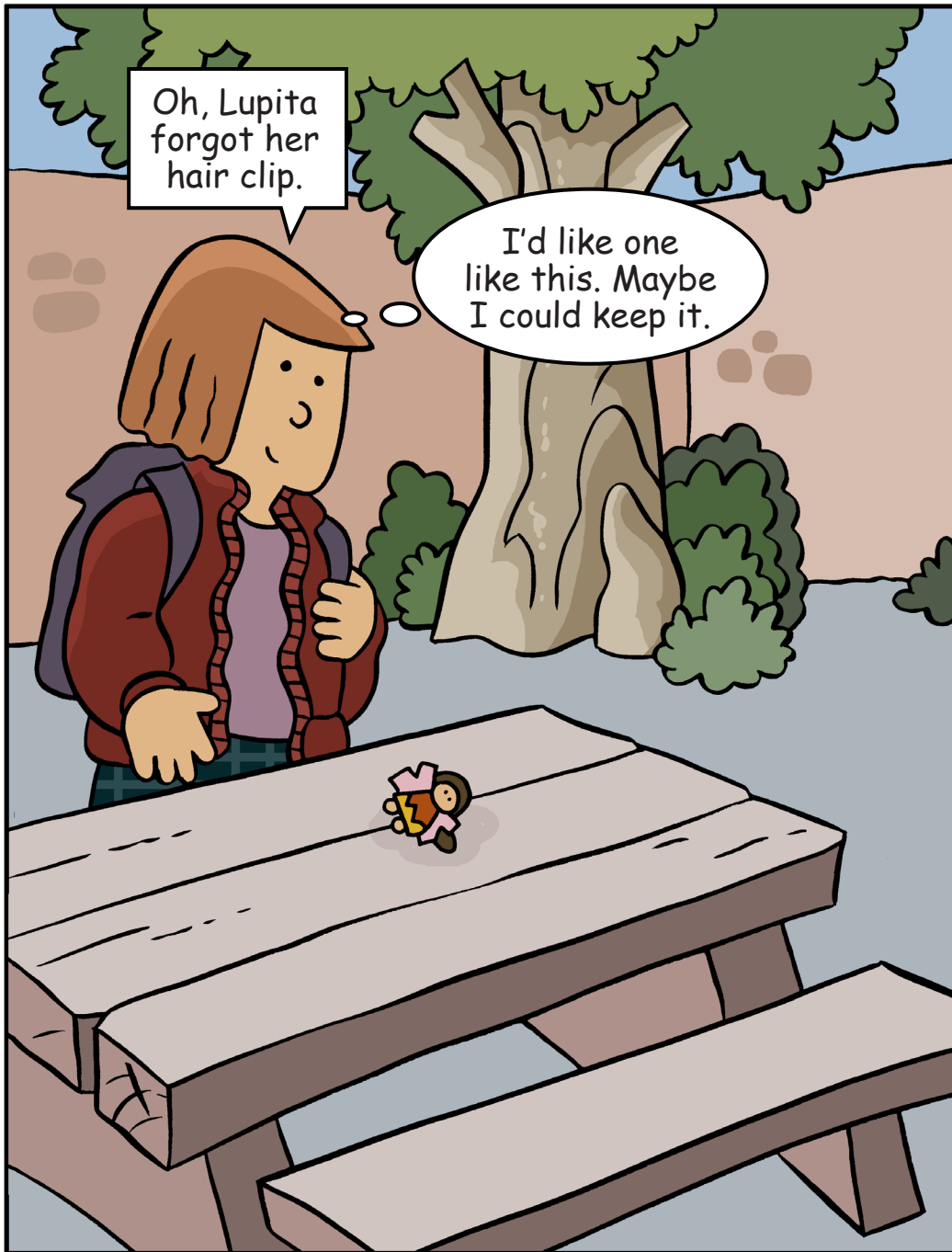
We will be considerate of the needs of others. And for sure we won't want to steal from them, because we know how we would feel if something of ours was stolen.

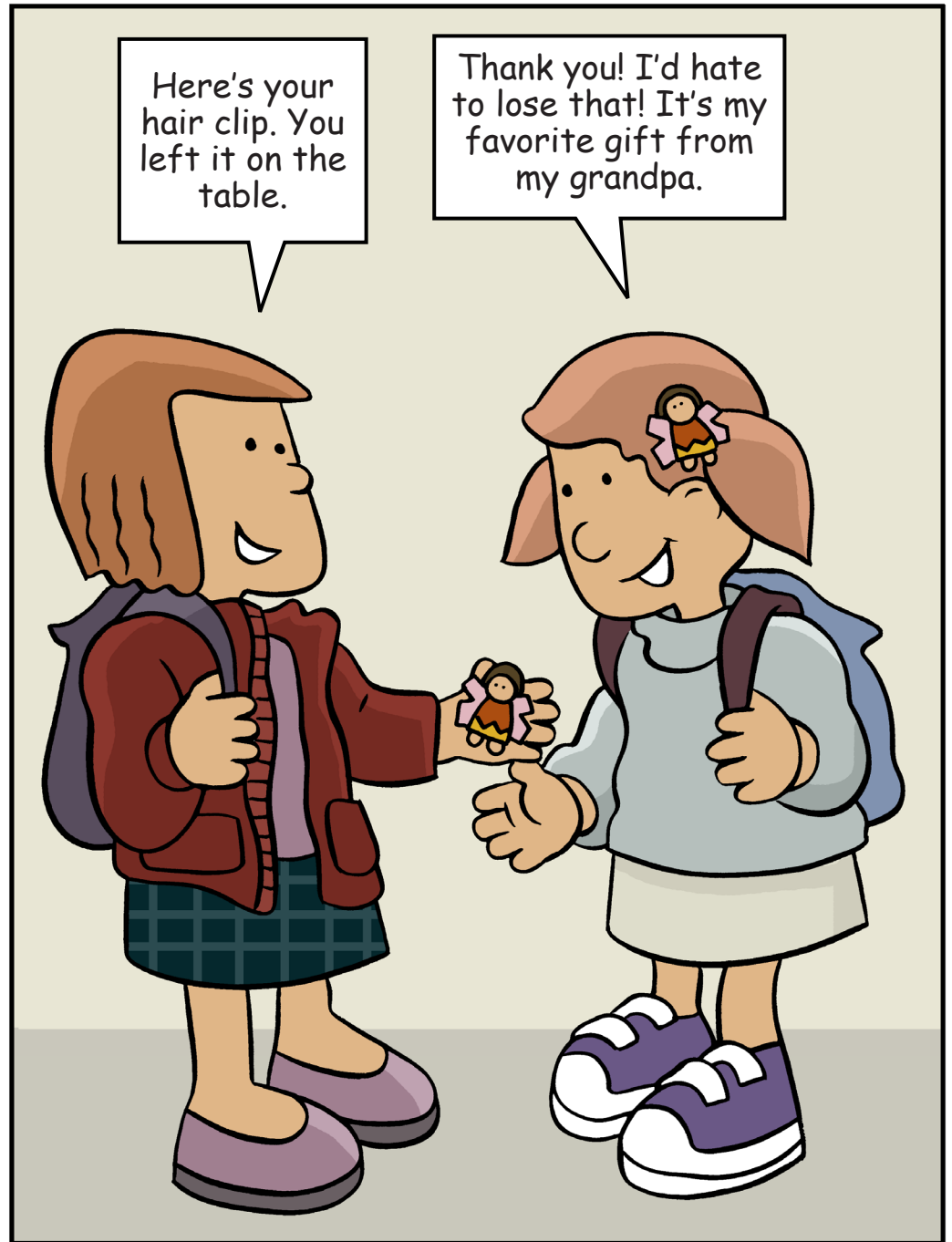
Give, Don't Steal
