(Acts 1:2–8 and 2:1–4)

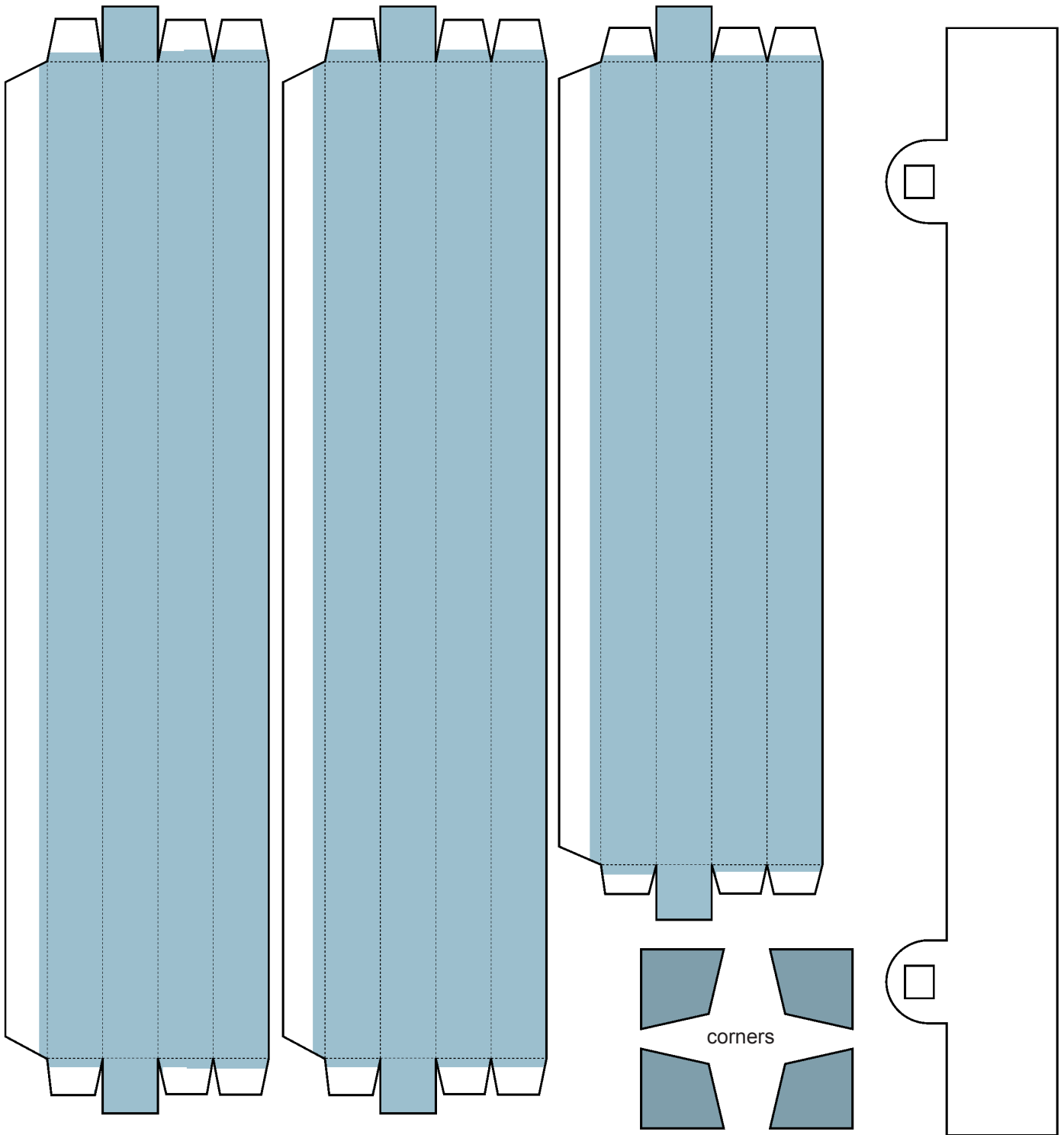
Jesus visited with His disciples during the first forty days after His resurrection and taught them more about the kingdom of God.

Before Jesus returned to heaven, He told them to wait together in Jerusalem to be baptized with His Holy Spirit.

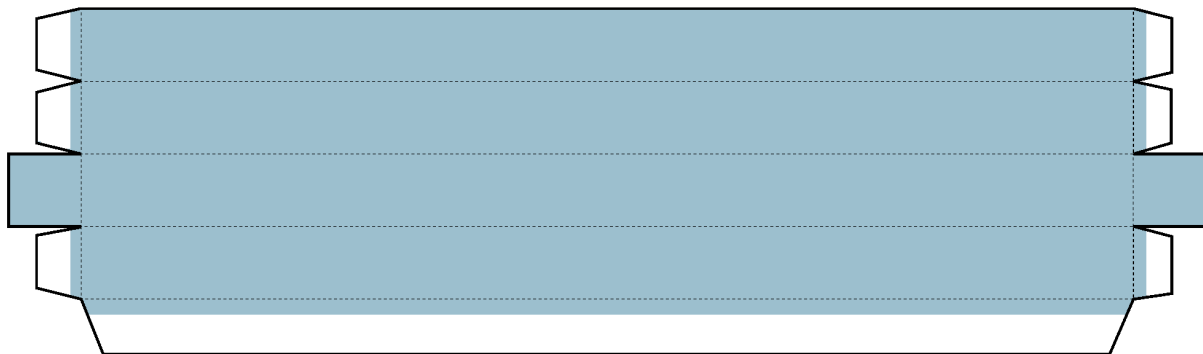
He promised the disciples that with the gift of the Holy Spirit they would receive great power to witness about Him to people all over the world.

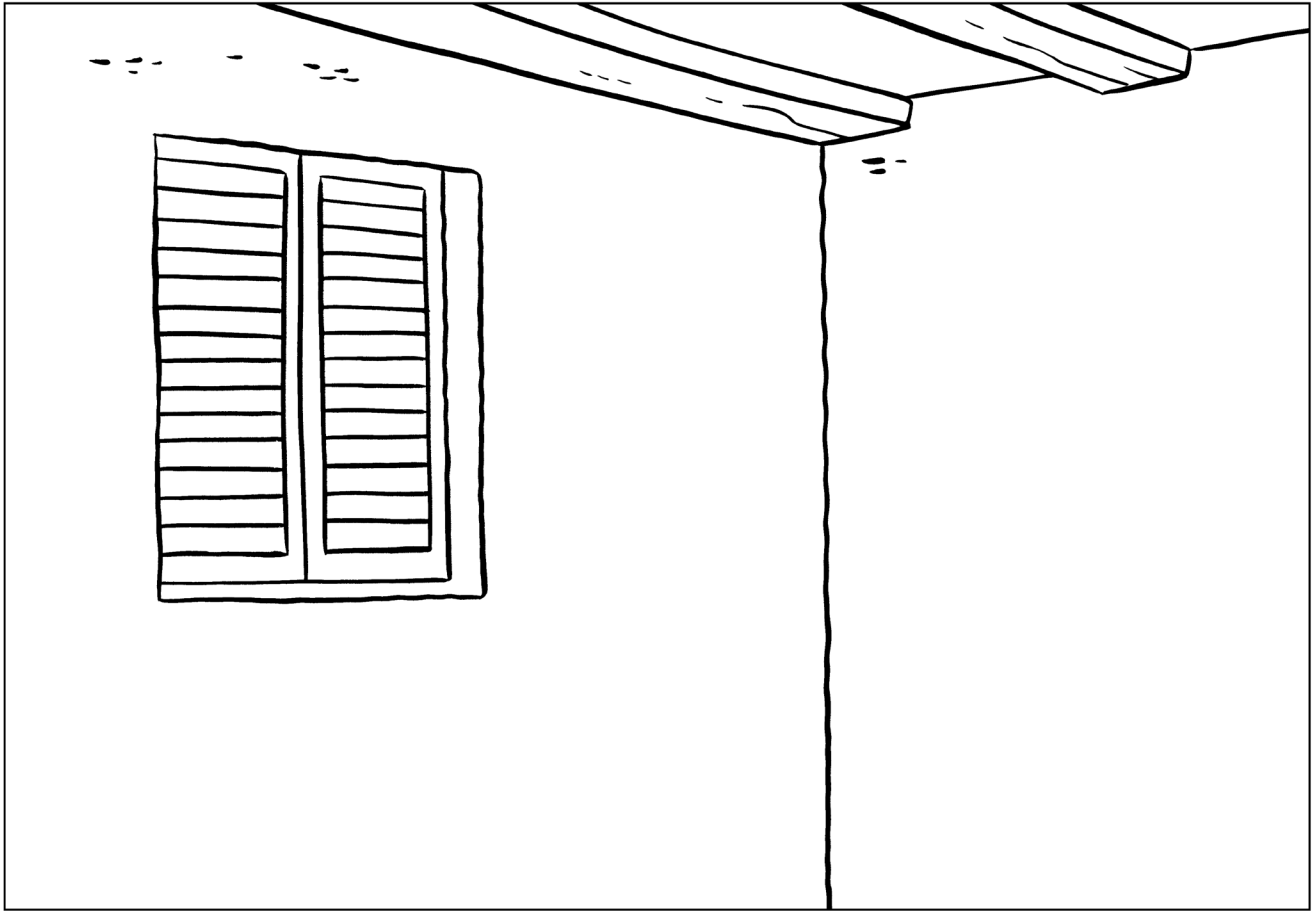

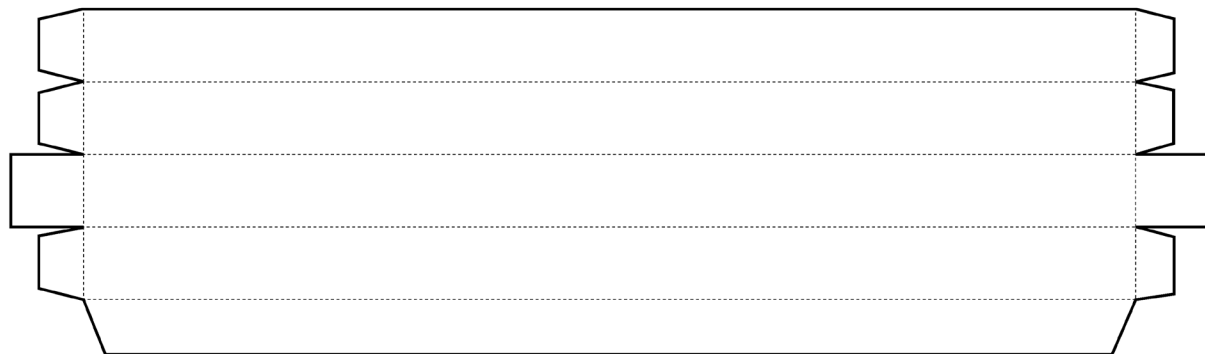
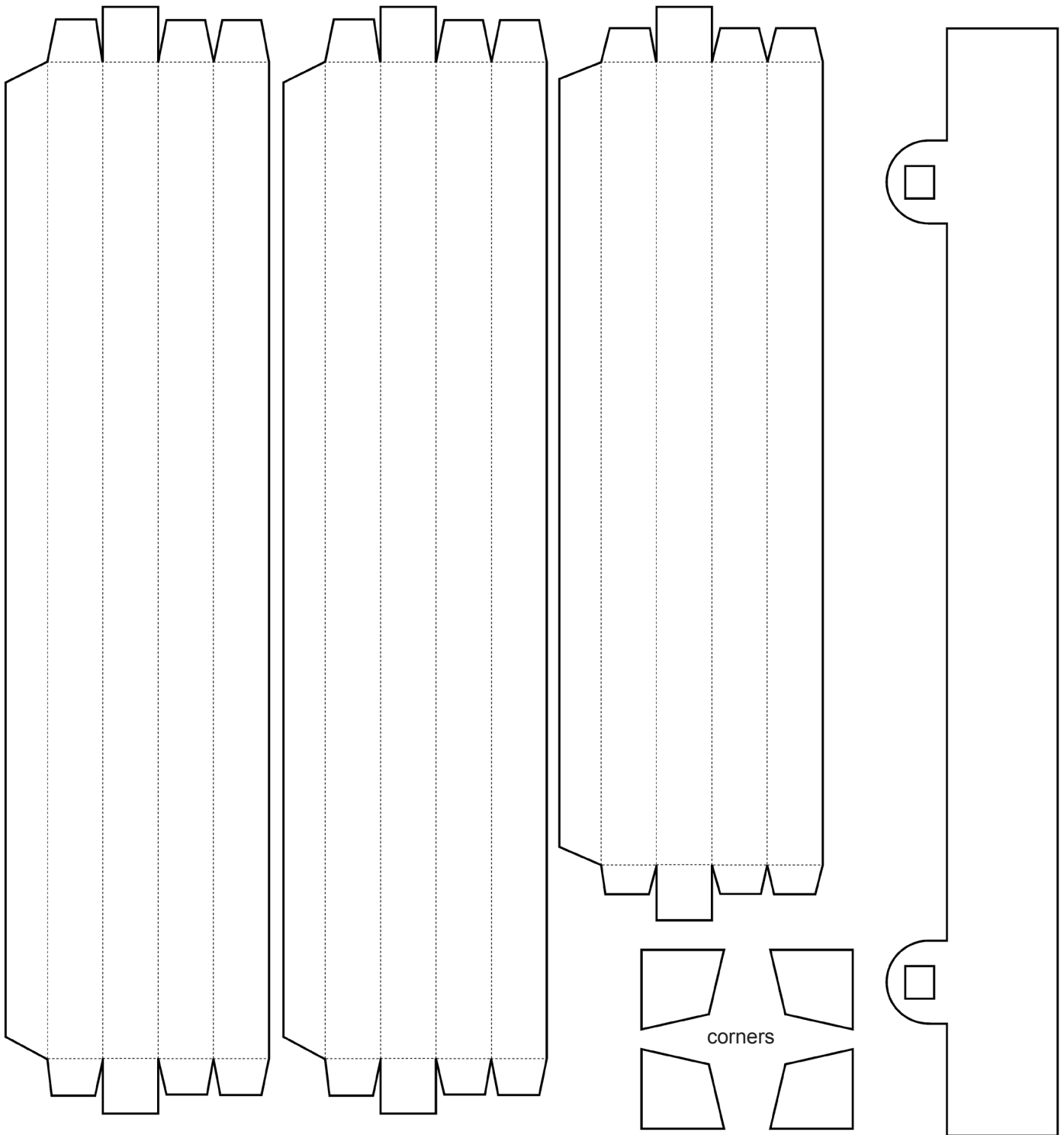
