


Read more about how Daniel and his friends stayed true to their beliefs in Daniel 1–3, and 6.



My friends, Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego, and I were taken to Babylon to be trained in the ways of the Babylonians.

- Daniel 1 tells the story of how God blessed them for only eating healthy pulse (peas, beans, and grain) and not the king's food.
- Daniel 3 tells the story about how Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were thrown into the fiery furnace because they wouldn't bow down to the statue of King Nebuchadnezzar.

The four young men studied diligently without abandoning their beliefs, and stayed strong in their convictions about God's ways.

Because they stayed true to God, He miraculously cared for them during very difficult circumstances.
