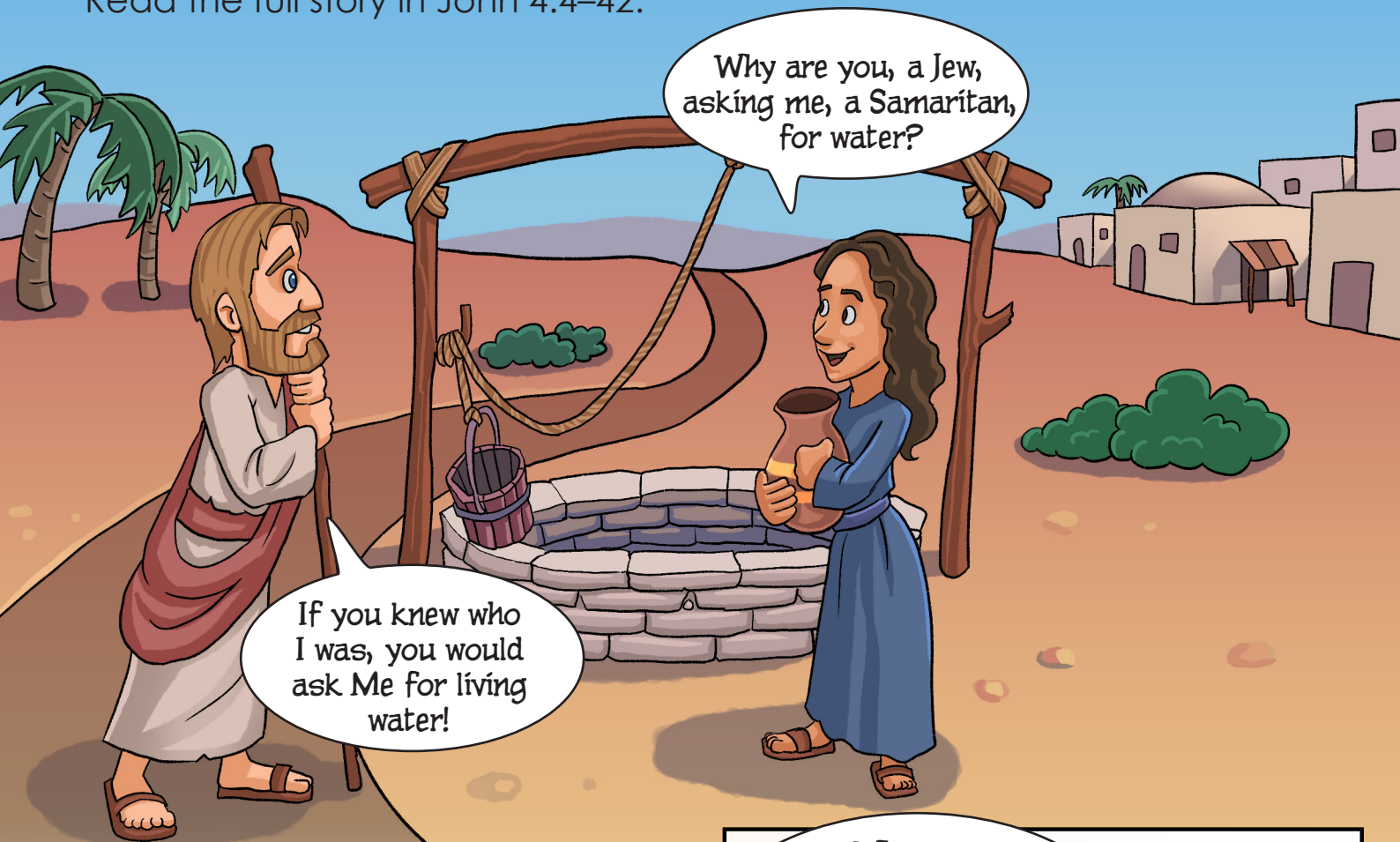


Read the full story in John 4:4–42.
