



Question: Do I consider what another person needs instead of only thinking of my personal desires?




Question: When a job needs to be done that I can help with, do I offer to help?




Question: Do I look for ways to help others not feel left out?



Question: Do I share my toys with others?




Question: When playing together, do I ever let others choose instead of always insisting on them doing what I want to do?
