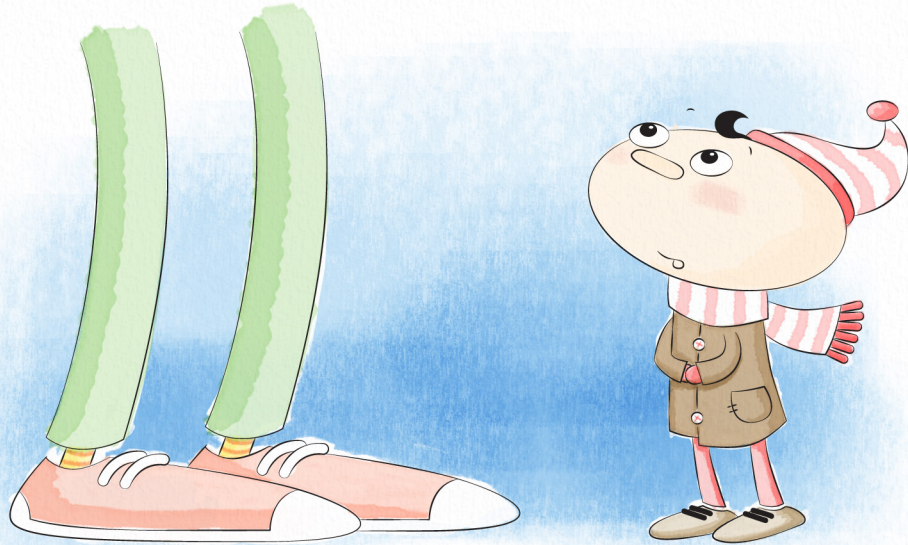


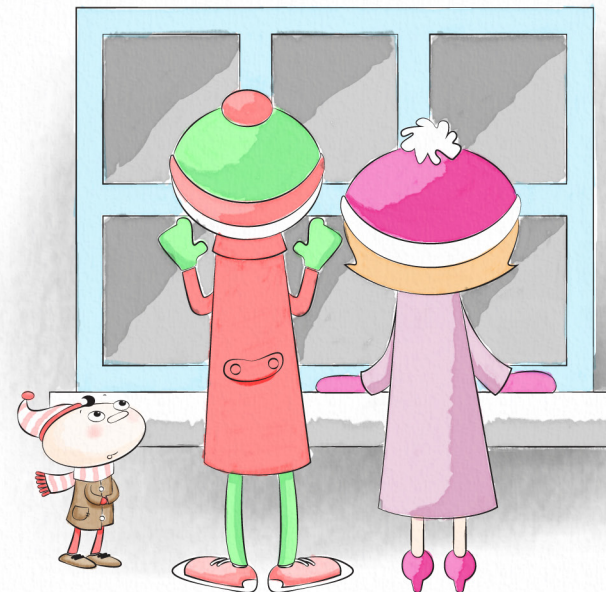
Are You Small Enough?



Bobby is five years old. He is growing up, but some days he feels very small.

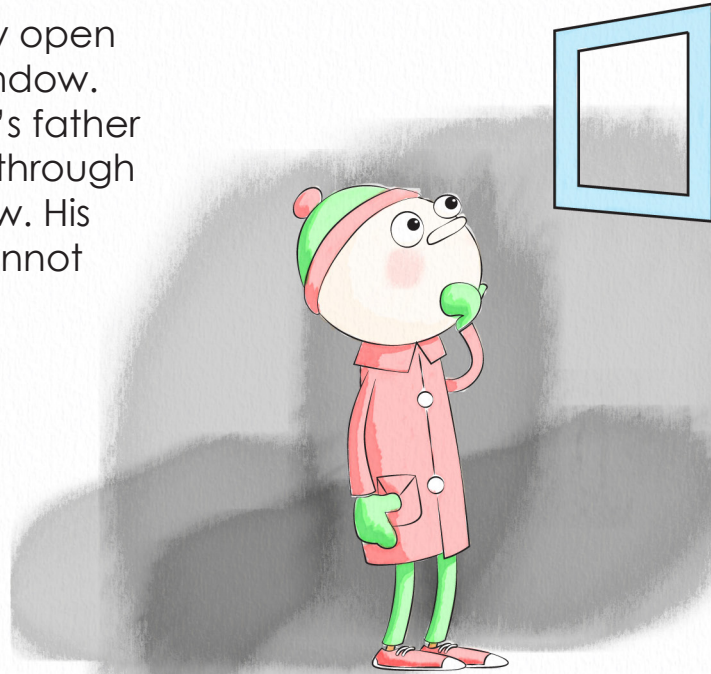
"I wish I were all grown up," Bobby says to himself. "I could do important things if I were bigger."
